

1. TEAK WOOD TABLETS

Teak Wood Tablets are supplied in two versions:

- Diagonal Cutting for Wall Art, Wall Coverings, Sound Diffusers and mirror frames
- With straight cut for standard headboards and modular headboards

2. COLLAGE BASES

Wall Art Bases

- Bases can be used with Plywood or MDF
- The Parkiet Brasil bases (fig 3) are produced 1" smaller than Art, to create an aesthetic setback, and are supplied with self-adhesive side brackets
- MDF bases can be used, with or without side recess or visible edge (fig 4).
- We recommend applying paper tape to the edges to protect from excess glue during gluing

Bases for Modular Headboards and Wall Coverings

- Supplied in resistant 0.8mm thick HDS Laminate (fig 5).

3. ADHESIVES FOR COLLAGE

Adhesives for gluing onto bases

- For uncoated Plywood or MDF bases, use PVA Wood Adhesives
- For bases on HDS Laminate, use single-component Polyurethane Adhesive
- For coated MDF bases, use Mounting Adhesives

4. GLUING THE TABLETS

Regular Collage

- Once the first tablet is positioned, glue the second one by turning it 90° clockwise (fig 7) compared to the previous tablet. Do the same procedure for the subsequent ones.

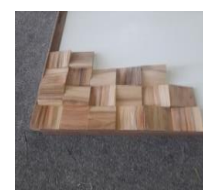
