

# Simulator – User Guide

## Step 1

### Register your Login (Registration) – Fill in the Fields:

- Name (Ex: Leonardo da Vinci).
- E-mail (Enter your email)
- Confirm your e-mail
- Password (We suggest 6 numeric digits – Ex: 123456)
- Confirm the password (Ex: 123456)
- Click “Send”
- Ready! After registering your Login, the screen will appear for you to create your project!

## Step 2

### Creating your Wall Wood Art:

- Click on “Create one now” or “New Project”.
- Enter your project code “PROJECT ID” with 3 letters and 6 numbers (Ex: ABC010203). This code cannot be used by another user.
- Choose the format of your project in (Project Format). You can create unique wall wood art or sets.
- Enter the dimensions of your Panel, width and height, in centimeters (Ex: width 120 – height 70). Dimensions must be multiples of 5cm – Observe the maximum and minimum limits for the total dimension.
- Click “Start editing”. The screen will appear in the dimensions you entered, with the tablets in Natural Teak color; Click on a color in the Color Palette and start your work of art. If you get a color wrong, repaint this tablet with the original color (13 – Natural Teak).
- We suggest you periodically save your project during creation. Before “Exit” or “Close the project”, click “Save”. You can change the colors and stop your project at any time and continue later.
- You can also make a copy of your project to change some color. In “My Projects”, choose the project to be copied and click “Copy Project”. A screen will appear for you to enter a new Project ID for the copy.
- Your Panel will be in your LOGIN, in “My Simulations”. To continue or change it, click “EDIT”.
- Important! Only click “Finish” when you have definitively completed your Project.
- In “Finished Projects” you will find the fields “DOWNLOAD” to generate the Collage Diagram and “EXPORT” to generate the list of tablets necessary for your project.

Attention: As this is a virtual simulation, the colors presented in the simulator may show small differences. Actual colors can be seen in the “Color Palette” under Downloads on the Website.
